

OOP-F2012: Exam guidelines

TIME & PLACE

Wednesday, June 6th, 2012 at 4pm - 8pm.

The exam starts at 4pm and ends at 8pm.

EXAM RULES

- The exam is to be completed individually.
- Discussing an exam assignment with or consulting others during this time can result in disciplinary action.
- Random checks may take place after the exam where there is a suspicion of plagiarism.

HOW THE EXAM IS SCORED

- Written work without oral exam. 7-point marking scale.
- The exam consists of a total of 4 assignments. Each assignment will individually be scored a number of points. Each student can collect a maximum of 100 points in total.

LOCATION

- The exam is a written home exam and can be completed as long as you ~~you~~ have internet access.
- Please, make sure to log in to LearnIT with your ITU username and password at least 15 min. before the exam starts.
- Multiple logins are not allowed, that is, a student may not be logged in from several simultaneous sessions. If a student has multiple login sessions, they will all be closed down by the LearnIT administrator.

YOU WILL NEED

- Computer with Java 5.0 or later and NetBeans installed.
- Internet access
- LearnIT login

YOU WILL NOT NEED

- Access to Adobe Connect Pro
- Headset/Webcam
- Anything else, which is not explicitly mentioned in the previous Section "YOU WILL NEED".

HELP & SUPPORT

- You are required to have a feasible Internet connection which you are fully responsible for. ITU is not responsible for Internet connection failures that might occur at a student's end.
- ITU is responsible for the access to the LearnIT server. Any problems with LearnIT should be immediately reported by the students either by email (to anco@itu.dk and/or yoo@itu.dk) or by phone (2916 0847 and/or 7218 5231).
- You are required to document break down with screen dumps or the like.
- The teaching team will be available for questions via chat in LearnIT throughout the entire exam.

HOW THE EXAM WILL WORK

The 4 assignments will be accessible from the OOPF2012 course page in LearnIT.

Each assignment will be made available in temporal sequence along with a deadline for the completion and upload of the assignment into LearnIT. The exact time and deadline for uploading your solution to each assignment will be made public in LearnIT at the start of the exam.

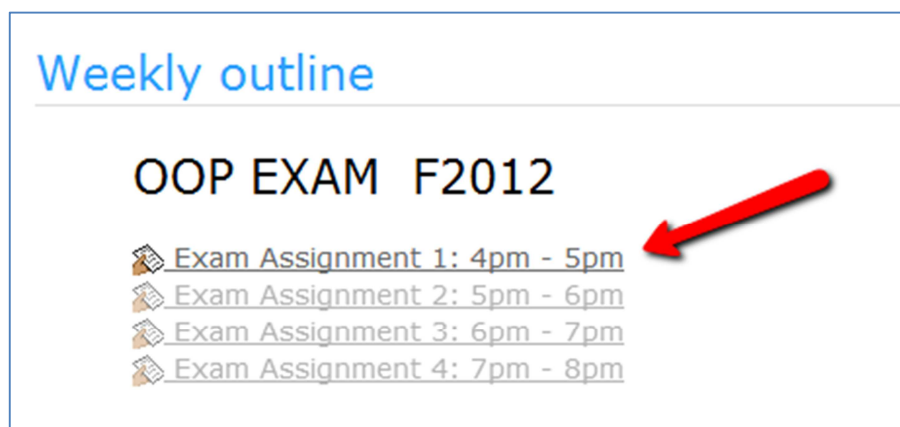


Figure 1: to upload your solution to Assignment 1 within the given time frame, click on the link "Exam Assignment 1: 4pm – 5pm" (notice, that the actual time at the exam might differ from this example)

Once, the time allocated to submit an assignment has elapsed, the next assignment will be posted in LearnIT and you may no longer submit any previous assignment. Submission of an assignment occurs in the same way as the submission of the individual solution of the weekly assignments (see Figure 1).

Explanatory example (please notice that times might change at the exam):

The exam starts at 16:00.

At 16:00, the first assignment will be available in LearnIT. You must submit your assignment by 17:05. After 17:05, you may no longer submit your answer linked to this particular assignment.

At 17:00, the first assignment will be available in LearnIT. You must submit your assignment by 17:05.
After 18:05, you may no longer submit your answer linked to this particular assignment.

At 18:00, the first assignment will be available in LearnIT. You must submit your assignment by 17:05.
After 19:05, you may no longer submit your answer linked to this particular assignment.

At 19:00, the first assignment will be available in LearnIT. You must submit your assignment by 17:05.
After 20:05, you may no longer submit your answer linked to this particular assignment.
